

'Preparations For Chardham Yatra Have Begun': Uttarakhand CM Dhama

Dehradun: Uttarakhand Chief Minister Pushkar Singh Dhama said on Tuesday that preparations for the Chardham Yatra are underway, with proper roads and accommodation being developed.

Speaking to reporters, CM said, "The Chardham Yatra is underway. All preparations have already begun. Proper roads and accommodations are being built. The convenience and safety of the pilgrims and tourists who are coming are both very important to us. A meeting has been held regarding this, and all preparations are progressing well. We are working on alternative options to address the global gas crisis. Our Forest Corporation will supply wood. Other departments, at whatever level, will work together to ensure a successful Chardham Yatra. Our state is fully prepared



for the Chardham Yatra." He also discussed the West Bengal elections, stating that the people want a change in government as the TMC has created an atmosphere of fear. "There is a wave of change among the people in West Bengal this time, and people want to change the government there. The TMC government there has completely acted like a syndicate and has cre-

ated an atmosphere of fear. People want a double-engine government there. Under the leadership of Prime Minister Modi, wherever elections are being held in states, people are deploying double-engine power; double-engine governments are being formed," he stated. The annual Char Dham Yatra, which includes pilgrimages to Kedarnath, Badrinath,

Gangotri, and Yamunotri, is one of the most significant religious journeys in Hinduism.

It is believed that one should complete the Char Dham Yatra in a clockwise direction. Hence, the pilgrimage starts from Yamunotri, proceeds towards Gangotri, onto Kedarnath, and finally ends at Badrinath.

The journey can be completed by road or by air (helicopter services are available). Some devotees even do a Do Dham Yatra or a pilgrimage to two shrines, Kedarnath and Badrinath, as per the Uttarakhand tourism official website. The Char Dham Yatra, or pilgrimage, is a tour of four holy sites: Yamunotri, Gangotri, Kedarnath and Badrinath. In Hindi, 'char' means four and 'dham' refers to religious destinations, as per the Uttarakhand tourism official website. —ANI

CM Dhama Urges People To Visit Bageshwar's Ancient Dhauling Devta Temple

Dehradun: Uttarakhand Chief Minister Pushkar Singh Dhama on Tuesday spoke about the significance of the Dhauling Devta Temple located in the Vijaypur area of Bageshwar district, describing it as an important centre of faith and devotion in the region.

Taking to X, the Chief Minister wrote, "The Dhauling Devta Temple, located in the Vijaypur area of Bageshwar district, is a major centre of faith and devotion."

His remarks brought renewed attention to the temple's religious and cultural importance in the Kumaon region. CM Dhama further noted that special worship and rituals are organised at the temple on occasions such as Rishi Panchami, Naag Panchami, and Navratri Panchami, drawing large numbers of devotees from nearby areas and beyond. Emphasising its spiri-



itual appeal, he added, "Upon arriving in Bageshwar, you too must

certainly pay a visit to this sacred temple."

The post was accompanied by a 37-second video showcasing scenic visuals of the temple premises, including panoramic mountain views, temple bells, and devotees engaged in worship, highlighting the serene and devotional atmosphere of the site.

Dhaulting Devta, also referred to as Dhaulti Nag or the 'White Snake God', is a prominent Naga deity worshipped primarily in the Vijaypur region of Uttarakhand's Kumaon belt. The temple is situated atop a picturesque hill at an altitude of approximately 1,840 metres, around 1.5 to 2 kilometres from Vijaypur town and about 25 kilometres from Bageshwar, offering sweeping views of the Himalayan landscape surrounded by dense forests of pine, oak, and rhododendron.

According to local belief, Dhaulting is regarded as the son of Kaliya Nag, the serpent from the Yamuna, subdued by Lord Krishna. Following

Krishna's victory, it is believed that Kaliya Nag and his family migrated to the Kumaon hills. Dhaulting, considered the eldest son, is said to have arrived in the Bageshwar region, with his name 'White Snake' symbolising purity and calmness.

Legends narrate that Dhaulting undertook intense penance dedicated to Lord Shiva, eventually transforming from a potentially fearsome entity into a benevolent guardian revered by local communities.

A widely shared local folklore explains his enduring connection with the people of the region. It is believed that upon arriving in the Vijaypur hills, Dhaulting resided in an oak tree. During a forest fire one night, he called out for help. While the Kandpals of Kanda could not respond, the Dhapolas of Dhapolasera alerted the Chandolas of Pokhri, along with the Churmals and Bhoos, who collectively helped rescue him and guide him to safety.

In gratitude, Dhaulting is believed to have blessed these communities and vowed to protect the surrounding region, including 22 villages, becoming their Ishtadevta or Kuldevta. This episode continues to shape local traditions and devotional practices even today.

Another version of the folklore suggests that upon his arrival in the region, Dhaulting called out to various community groups, who then served him and received his blessings of protection.

He is also believed to have entrusted specific families, including the Pant and Dhama lineages, with the responsibility of performing regular worship and rituals at the temple, a tradition that has been passed down through generations. A Shiv Ling installed within the temple further reinforces its deep association with Lord Shiva worship. —IANS

PM Garib Kalyan Anna Yojana: 3 Months' Rations Allocated In April

- Three Months' Rations Being Allocated in Advance in April Under PM Garib Kalyan Anna Yojana – Shri. P.S. Pangti, Additional Commissioner (Food, Civil Supplies and Consumer Affairs, Government of Uttarakhand),
- In Uttarakhand, 6,310 LPG cylinders will be supplied daily to hotels & resorts, restaurants & dhabas, guest houses, paying guest facilities, homestays, wedding functions, and industries
- In the state, migrant workers and students can obtain a 5 kg 'Chhotu' cylinder (FTL – Free Trade LPG) from any gas agency upon presenting valid ID proof.
- Under monitoring and enforcement in Uttarakhand, 6,205 inspections and 373 raids have been conducted against hoarding and black marketing, resulting in 19 FIRs, 7 arrests, and 16 notices issued
- Domestic LPG cylinder distribution remains normal, with over 1.8 million cylinders delivered to households since March 1, 2026. More than 6,700 units of 5 kg cylinders have been sold in the state

Dehradun (The Hawk): On Tuesday, at Press Information Bureau, Dehradun, Shri P.S. Pangti, Additional Commissioner (Food, Civil Supplies and Consumer Affairs, Government of Uttarakhand), briefed the media on the availability of LPG and other petroleum products, food security preparedness, and essential commodities.

As part of its ongoing efforts to keep the media informed about developments in West Asia, the Ministry of Information and Broadcasting, Government of India, organized a press conference at PIB, Dehradun.

Shri P.S. Pangti stated that the supply of domestic LPG is being regularly ensured across the state. There is no shortage of diesel and petrol, and gas supplies are being maintained

regularly to hospitals and educational institutions.

He informed that an SOP has been issued by the Uttarakhand Government for 66% distribution of commercial cylinders. Under this, 6,310 cylinders will be supplied daily to hotels and resorts, restaurants and dhabas, guest houses, paying guest facilities, homestays, wedding functions, and industries.

He further stated that special preparations have been made by the government for the upcoming Char Dham Yatra and wedding season. Keeping in view the pilgrimage and tourism season, the Chief Secretary of Uttarakhand has already sent a demand to the Government of India requesting restoration of 100% allocation of commercial LPG to the state from April to November,



along with an additional 5% quota.

Adequate availability of 5 kg cylinders for migrant workers and students has been ensured. All gas agencies in the state have been directed to maintain timely delivery. These 5 kg 'Chhotu' cylinders (FTL – Free Trade LPG) can be obtained from any gas agency upon presenting valid ID proof.

Under the Pradhan Mantri Garib Kalyan Anna Yojana, ration card holders of Antyodaya and Priority households are receiving three months' ration (April, May, and June) together in April from their nearest fair price shops. Around 1.4 million ration card holder families in the state are being allocated three months' ration at once.

Regarding panic booking, Shri Pangti informed that in the past 25 days, the highest number of bookings was recorded on March 15 at 90,000. However, the situation normalized by April 6, with bookings at 45,000. Currently, LPG booking in the state is at normal levels. On PNG, he stated that efforts are being made on a war footing to expand PNG connections across the state. As per Government of India directives, five City Gas Distribution companies are working in Uttarakhand to expand PNG and alternative fuel infrastructure. These include GAIL Gas in Dehradun, IOC-Adani Gas Pvt. Ltd. in Udham Singh Nagar, HNGPL in Haridwar, and HPCL in Nainital.

There are no disruptions or restrictions in the supply of CNG, domestic PNG, and commercial and

industrial PNG in the state. These companies are taking steps to rapidly expand domestic PNG connections, ensure maximum coverage in minimum time, prioritize surveys and institutional connections, monitor daily progress, and set priorities based on public interest. Currently, around 37,000 households in the state have active PNG connections.

Regarding alternative fuel arrangements, the Forest Department has ensured adequate availability of wood at all timber depots across the state.

Regular monitoring and enforcement actions are being carried out in Uttarakhand to curb hoarding and black marketing. So far, 6,205 inspections and 373 raids have been conducted, resulting in 19 FIRs, 7 arrests, and 16 notices issued.
